They are trying trick people and steal that money.

Don't let them!

That money is to help you through hard times.

Scammers might email you, ring you, or message you

They will ask for your bank account details.

Don't give your bank account details to anyone. That's how scammers steal your money.

Don't tell anyone your personal information like your name, address, or phone number.

If someone sends you a link in an email or text message, don't click on it.

If someone tries to trick you and steal your money, or if you hear about a scam from family, you can report them.
